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Chat GPT is an excellent tool, best used for editing and 'filling in the gaps'. Whilst it can be used to create full blogs, this does not follow blogging best practice, as the content will lack originality. This **can** have a negative impact on SEO. That being said, any relevant blog posts will be more beneficial than not blogging at all!
