



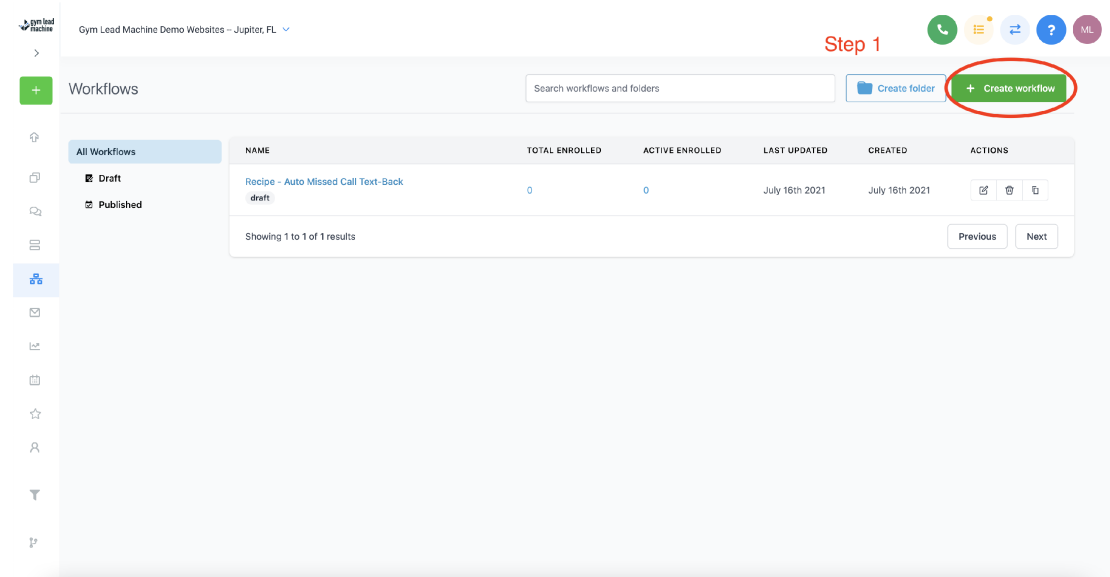

Copy a Workflow

You can copy over existing campaigns into the Workflow Builder. This is a helpful tool if you want to reuse and repurpose campaigns for new automations that you want to create. To copy over an existing campaign into a new Workflow, follow the steps below:

1. In the Workflows menu, click *Create Workflow*
2. Under the section that says *Import From a Campaign*, click the dropdown arrow and then select the campaign that you want to copy over into the Workflow
3. Once the campaign is selected, click the button that says *Create a New Workflow*
4. Click *Add a New Workflow Trigger* to set the trigger you want to use to activate the campaign
